Brooklyn hung out with Chris and Miles while we were in the northland.

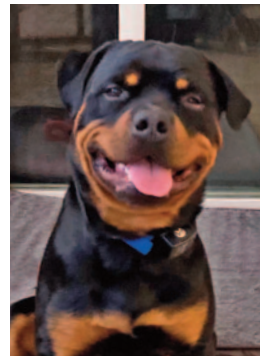
There was so much snow to see on our travels. It was on the passes, hills, trees, and mountains. Both Mt. Shasta and Black Butte were so white!
