Illinois House Work

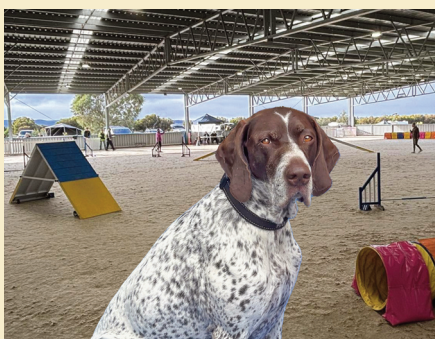
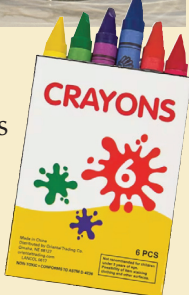
